**INTRODUCTION:** The Public Procurement Authority (PPA) is a public entity in the State of Oregon formed by an Intergovernmental Agreement pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes Chapter 190 (Intergovernmental Cooperation). The PPA was formed to provide procurement opportunities to its members as well as members participating in the National Purchasing Partners (NPPGov). The State of Hawaii has signed a Memorandum of Understanding pursuant to §103D, Part VIII, Government Relations & Cooperative Purchasing, and §3-128, Hawaii Administrative Rules to participate with PPA FireRescue solicitations.

The objective of this cooperative group is to obtain volume price discounts based on the collective volume of the numerous potential purchases by the individual States and their various governmental entities. The benefits of cooperative procurements are the potential administrative and contract management savings realized by contractors from their administration and management of a single, comprehensive contract, rather than multiple contracts for various State governments and governmental entities. Concurrently, the various State governmental entities also realize these same administrative and management benefits.
