

NOTICE TO BIDDERS  
(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for RUNWAY 3-21 AND TAXIWAY B REHABILITATION AT LIHUE AIRPORT, LIHUE, KAUAI, HAWAII, STATE PROJECT NO. AK1031-15(R), AIP PROJECT NO. 3-15-0013-XX, will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation (DOT), 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii, 96813, or at the Office of the District Engineer – Kauai, 1720 Haleukana Street, Lihue, Hawaii, 96766 until 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), June 16, 2016, at which time and places they will be opened and read. Bids received after said due date and time shall not be considered.

The scope of work consists of milling the existing pavement and repaving Runway 3-21, Taxiway B, and adjoining taxiways with a nominally 4” thick asphalt concrete pavement. The scope also includes pavement markings and grooving for the resurfaced areas pursuant to the plans and specifications. The estimated cost of construction is between \$15,000,000.00 and \$18,000,000.00.

To be eligible for award, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii General Engineering Contractor’s “A” license prior to the award of contract.

A compact disc containing the plans, specifications, and proposal contract forms may be obtained from the said bid receiving offices. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a clearly identified sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by the DOT. The "General Provisions" applicable to this project are available for viewing on the internet at <http://hidot.hawaii.gov/administration/con/>.

A pre-bid conference is scheduled for 10:00 A.M., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), May 25, 2016, at the Lihue Airport, Administrative Conference Room, to explain and clarify any

questions regarding this project and to provide firms with an opportunity to ask questions about the DBE requirements and to inform DBEs of contracting, subcontracting and vendor opportunities. All prospective bidders or their representatives (employees) are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory. Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body. 
