SEALED BIDS for MAINTENANCE AND STAFFING FOR AUTOMATED PASSPORT CONTROL KIOSKS, KONA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, ISLAND OF HAWAII, PROJECT NO. BH2725-93R, will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, at the office of the District Engineer - Hawaii, 50 Makaala Street, Hilo, Hawaii 96720, until 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), December 1 , 2016, at which time and place(s) they will be publicly opened and read.

The scope of work includes providing assistance to passengers in the operation of ten (10) operating automated passport control kiosks located in the Federal Inspection Station(FIS). Provide bilingual staffing to qualify passengers arriving from foreign countries prior to entering a designated area within the Customs and Boarder Protection's area within the FIS.

A compact disc containing the specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above office. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to ACT 175, SLH 2009 is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO Form 38) to the Department of Transportation Contracts Office no later than 4:30 p.m., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the Department.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors.

The U.S. Department of Transportation Regulation entitled "Nondiscrimination in Federally-Assisted Programs of


