

NOTICE TO BIDDERS  
(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for MONITORING, MAINTENANCE AND EMERGENCY REPAIRS FOR THE POTABLE AND NONPOTABLE WATER SYSTEMS, HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, ISLAND OF OAHU, PROJECT NO. BO1721-73, will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, until 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), September 22, 2016, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

A compact disc containing the specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above office. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The scope of work includes: obtaining water consumption through reading meters; monitoring and maintaining the water system at Honolulu International Airport (HNL); performing maintenance and flow testing on fire hydrants; performing maintenance on water valves and air valves; maintenance on potable water loading bridges, testing and certification of backflow prevention devices; operation and maintenance of the HNL water quality monitoring stations; and performing various unforeseen work inclusive but no limited to valve closures, emergency repairs, equipment replacement, and sampling drinking water for microbiological testing.

General system plans may be examined by appointment only at the State of Hawaii Department of Transportation, Airports Division, Contract Maintenance Unit, located at 300 Rodgers Boulevard #12, 5th Floor, Honolulu, Hawaii 96819-1880. Appointments may be made by contacting the Oahu District Engineer's Office at (808) 836-6628.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to ACT 175, SLH 2009 is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO Form 38) to the Department of Transportation Contracts Office no later than 4:30 p.m., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the Department.

A separate SPO-38 form shall be completed and submitted for each product. The form is available at <http://hawaii.gov/spo/goods-services-construction/preferences-103d-pt-x/preferences>.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii, General Engineering "A" license. Personnel for this project shall hold a current Distribution System Operator, Class 4 Certificate issued by the Hawaii State Department of Health. Personnel conducting the backflow preventer maintenance shall be certified by the Plumbing and Mechanical Contractor's Association of Hawaii (PAMCAH) or the University of Southern California Foundation for Cross Connection Control & Hydraulic Research.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body.
