

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for SHORELINE CLEANUP AT HONOLULU INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, HONOLULU, HAWAII, PROJECT NO. BO1731-23, will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813, until 2:00 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time (HST), November 17, 2016, at which time and place they will be publicly opened and read.

A compact disc containing the specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above office. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The scope of work consists of the clearing and removal of all fugitive and non-fugitive debris/solid waste (in general, any and all garbage and refuse), including the cleaning and removal of loose and dead vegetation, and live vegetation for obvious stretches of property intended to be landscape-free. That is, no vegetation taking root. The work obligation is committed to the shorelines of Lagoon Drive, the Reef Runway, Taxiways RA and RB (West & East sides). The limits of clearing and removal work will be within the property fence line and/or shoulder ground of a sloping band, down the graded bank and up to the low tide water mark.

A pre-bid meeting, with on-site inspection, will be held at 10:00 a.m., October 26, 2016 at the Honolulu International Airport, Inter-Island Terminal Building (IITB), 7th Floor, Conference Room B.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to ACT 175, SLH 2009 is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and qualify a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO Form 38) to the Department of Transportation Contracts Office no later than 4:30 p.m., fourteen (14) calendar days prior to the bid opening date. Late submittals for this project will not be reviewed by the Department.


