INTRODUCTION: The U.S. General Services Administration (GSA) Cooperative Purchasing Program, authorized by statute, allows state and local government to purchase a variety of commercial supplies (products) and services under specific GSA Schedule contracts to save time, money, and meet everyday needs and missions. By using the purchasing power of the federal government, GSA can help States, cities, and towns meet their mission while reducing costs and maximizing efficiencies.

NOTICE: The State Procurement Office, on behalf of the State of Hawaii, including all executive branch agencies and Chief Procurement Officer jurisdictions, pursuant to section 103D-203, Hawaii Revised Statutes, intends to participate in the GSA Schedule 70, Commercial IT Products, Services and Solutions. All interested vendors, not already awarded a GSA Schedule 70 contract, are invited to register and submit a proposal to GSA. The solicitation for IT Products, Services and Solutions is currently standing (ongoing); with no closing date, which therefore qualifies as an authorized cooperative agreement under Hawaii laws. Interested vendors are forewarned that the GSA registration and proposal process may be lengthy.
