

NOTICE TO BIDDERS
(Chapter 103D, HRS)

SEALED BIDS for TREE TRIMMING AND REMOVAL AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ON STATE HIGHWAYS, PROJECT NO. HWY-HM-2016-02, ISLAND OF HAWAII, will be received at the Contracts Office, Department of Transportation, 869 Punchbowl Street, Honolulu, Hawaii 96813 or at the office of the District Engineer – Hawaii, 50 Makaala Street Hilo, Hawaii 96720 until 2:00 P.M., Hawaii Standard Time (HST) August 18, 2016, at which time and places they will be publicly opened and read.

A compact disc containing the specifications, proposal and contract forms may be obtained from the above office. Bids (hard copies) shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

The scope of work consists of trimming and or removal of trees on an indefinite quantity “as-needed” basis during the twelve (12) month period of the contract, all in accordance with the requirements of these Specifications. The Contractor shall be able to respond to services that includes emergency miscellaneous work which requires a response time and commencement of work within two (2) hours of receiving verbal notification from the Engineer or his representative.

Only bids from bidders who, at the date of bid, possess a minimum of two (2) consecutive years of a valid State of Hawaii Specialty Contractor’s C-27B, Tree Trimming and Removal or C-27, Landscaping contractor license will be considered. Bidder’s attention is also directed to Section 2.1 of the Special Provisions regarding additional bidder’s qualification.

Campaign contributions by State and County Contractors. Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-355, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by a legislative body. 
The Equal Employment Opportunity Regulations of the Secretary of Labor implementing Executive Order 11246, as amended, shall be complied with on this on this project.
