

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

CD-ROMS containing BID FORMS AND PLANS for IFB No. 14-0523, Photovoltaic Array for University of Hawaii West Oahu, will be available from and received in the OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT AND REAL PROPERTY MANAGEMENT (OPRPM), UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, 1400 LOWER CAMPUS ROAD, ROOM 15, HONOLULU, HAWAII 96822.

Written notice of Intention to Bid is no longer required for University of Hawaii Invitation for Bids.

Due to conditions at the site that may not be clearly identified in technical specifications and plans, it is highly recommended that all bidders attend a the pre-bid conference/job site walk-through at 1:00 p.m., May 8, 2014, at Building D (Classroom Building), Room D237 located on the University of Hawaii West Oahu, 91-1001 Farrington Highway, Kapolei, Hawaii 96707. Bidders must park in Parking Lot A which is the further West of the two parking lots.

Requests for Substitution/Clarification must be submitted to the Technical Representative, Bruce Teramoto, FAX (808) 956-3175, no later than **4:00 p.m., May 15, 2014**.

Bids must be submitted no later than **2:30 p.m., May 27, 2014** and at that time will be publicly opened at the Office of Procurement and Real Property Management.

Bids received after the due time and date(s) fixed above will not be considered.

The project shall generally consist of the furnishing and installing complete and operating ground mounted photovoltaic systems for FIVE (5) buildings, each with a rated capacity of 100kW. Design, documentation, and all permitting and approvals, including HECO interconnection study and building permits shall be provided along with construction, commissioning and associated work. The system shall include all PV panels and mounting hardware, ground preparation, fencing, civil works, inverter(s), isolation transformers (if required), switches, combiner boxes, wiring, interconnections, meters, and all balance of system (BOS) components and connections needed for a "turnkey" installation of the complete solar generating systems. All appropriate documentation, software, and any special maintenance tools must be included with the system.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii contractor's license A or B. **BIDS FROM CONTRACTORS NOT LICENSED IN THE STATE OF HAWAII WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
