

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

CD-ROMS containing BID FORMS AND PLANS for IFB No. 16-0581, POST BUILDING, REPLACE EMERGENCY GENERATOR SYSTEM, will be available from and received in the OFFICE OF PROCUREMENT AND REAL PROPERTY MANAGEMENT (OPRPM), UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII, 1400 LOWER CAMPUS ROAD, ROOM 15, HONOLULU, HAWAII 96822.

Written notice of Intention to Bid is no longer required for University of Hawaii Invitation for Bids.

Due to conditions at the site that may not be clearly identified in technical specifications and plans, it is highly recommended that all bidders attend the pre-bid conference/job site walk-through at 9:00 a.m., June 6, 2016, at the Facilities Management Office Conference Room, 2002 East West Road, Honolulu. Bidders enter through the upper campus Maile Way Gate and park in the Facilities Management Office parking stalls for the pre-bid conference. Overflow parking will be allowed in the Facilities Baseyard **after** checking in with the pre-bid conference coordinator.

Requests for Substitution/Clarification must be submitted to the Technical Representative, Daren Lui, Facilities Management Office, 2002 East West Road, Room A5, Honolulu, Hawaii, no later than **4:00 p.m., June 16, 2016**.

Bids must be submitted no later than **2:30 p.m., July 6, 2016** and at that time will be publicly opened at the Office of Procurement and Real Property Management.

Bids received after the due time and date(s) fixed above will not be considered.

The project shall generally consist of demolition and replacement of existing 700kW emergency generator and ASCO 940 1200A and 250A ATS units. Work also includes installation of a double-wall 500-gallon fuel tank, generator exhaust system, remote radiator, concrete, structural steel, fluid-applied membrane roofing, fuel oil distribution system, air supply distribution and ventilation, painting, control of lead paint, complete.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must possess a valid State of Hawaii contractor's license C-13. **BIDS FROM CONTRACTORS NOT LICENSED IN THE STATE OF HAWAII WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**
