

NOTICE TO PROVIDERS OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

In accordance with Section 103D-304, HRS, the Department of Transportation (DOT), Harbors Division, seeks the services of a qualified professional firm with expertise in electrical engineering consulting work.

The scope of work for this contract includes providing electrical engineering services for the Harbors Special Maintenance program at commercial harbors statewide - Job H.C. 90094. The services for the Harbors Division include, but are not limited to, inspections, surveys, electrical assessments/designs of harbors/waterfront facilities, conducting field investigations, reviewing existing plans, preparing complete contract drawings, specifications, reports, and cost estimates, providing services during construction, and other items related to maintaining, altering, or modifying electrical systems statewide.

The Harbors Division has budgeted \$200,000.00 for this contract.

Individuals or firms on the DOT's qualified list shall submit a summary of their qualifications that should include, and shall be evaluated by the following criteria:

1. Experience and professional qualifications relevant to this project = 40%,
2. Past performance on projects of similar scope for public agencies or private industry, including corrective actions and other responses to notices of deficiencies = 30%
3. Capacity to accomplish the work in the required time = 20%.
4. Familiarity with Harbors Division facilities and structures = 10%

Include in your firm's submittal Proof of Insurance for:

- a. General liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.
- b. Automobile liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.
- c. Professional liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per claim and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate.

If a firm is not able to provide the above insurance certificates at this time, a letter from an insurance company stating, if the firm is selected, they will insure the firm for the insurance policies and the amount of minimum coverage required above, will be accepted as proof of insurance.

Individuals or firms who are not on the DOT's qualified list, and wish to be considered in the selection for this project must also submit a separate PDF file of the following by the deadline as follows:

1. Letter of interest (including an email address for notification of additional advertisements);
2. Completed [DPW Form 120](#) or [Standard Federal Form 330](#),
3. Include in your firm's submittal Proof of Insurance for:
 - a. General liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.
 - b. Automobile liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident. The STATE shall be named as additional insured.
 - c. Professional liability insurance for limit of not less than \$1,000,000 per claim and \$2,000,000 annual aggregate.
4. Any other related information.

If a firm is not able to provide the above insurance certificates at this time, a letter from an insurance company stating, if the firm is selected, they will insure the firm for the insurance policies and the amount of minimum coverage required above, will be accepted as proof of insurance."
