**CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE TESTING SERVICES AND MEDICAL REVIEW OFFICER
SERVICES, STATEWIDE**

The following is the Department's response to questions posed:

1. Question: *Page OF-3. Please clarify what is meant by "Percentage of bid prices for Controlled Substance Specimen Testing and collection Service representing Labor: ___%"*

Response: Basically, of the quoted unit price for testing, what percentage, if any, comprises of labor that would be affected by an increase in the State's wage rate for "Medical Laboratory Technician."

Please see Special Provisions page SP-9 Contract Adjustment Pursuant to Section 103-55, HRS. In the future, should public employee wages for the Medical Laboratory Technician increase, the awarded Contractor may request for an increase in contract price. The percentage of bid price representing labor is a factor calculating the allowable price adjustment in the future.

2. Question: *Page OF-6. Section C asks for a minimum of two MDs or PhDs- is this a requirement?*

Response: After review, the Department will change the requirement to only one. Offerors are advised that on page OF-6, Item C. is amended to list a minimum of one (1) M.D. or Ph.D. and one toxicologist that will be providing controlled substance testing services under this contract. The offer forms are not amended, please use the original OF-6, and list at least one (1) for each M.D or Ph.D. and Toxicologist.

3. Question: *Page S-2. Collection Sites listed for each island – do these locations need to be all available 24/7 for after hour collections? Please clarify.*

Response: Yes, they need to provide us with some form of service 24/7. Currently, the arrangement is that the Lab has one of their staff on call with a pager, so if services are needed during afterhours /non-business hours, our facility contacts that staff person, and the person meets them at the Lab.
