The following addendum provides responses to written questions.


1. We are not currently registered with the State of Hawaii. Do we need to be registered with the state prior to submitting a bid?
 - a. As stated under Special Provisions, Section 2-Responsibility of Offerors, the selected Offeror shall be required to submit evidence of tax clearance by providing a Hawaii Compliance Express certificate dated within one month of the notice of award.

2. There are varying quantities listed in the RFP. Can you please clarify the department's expectations?
 - a. This proposal covers the design and development for a total of 30 signs; 25 of which will be installed at identified locales on Oahu, and the remaining five to be kept in storage as replacement signs.

3. Do you envision these signs to be multiple copies of the same design?
 - a. Yes. Dependent on funding in subsequent years, unique designs can be made for similar signage on Maui, Kauai, and Hawaii Island.

4. Do you have one or more photos available of the typical structures you plan to mount these to?
 - a. Where practicable the signs will be mounted on existing walls. It will be the contractors responsibility, in consultation with DLNR to identify general locations for sign placement and then which specific structures they will be placed on.
